What to bring:

Protective clothing

Supplied:

- **Fabric dyes** (reds, blues and yellows): Dylon cold water dye, \$12.95
- **Calico cotton cloth:** approx \$9 per metre (120cm) wide or Spotlight.
- **Hessian, muslin**
- **Cooking string**
- **Binda twine fabric**
- **Disposable gloves**
- **Newspaper**
- **String**
- **Rubber bands**
- **Paper clips**
- **Line**
- **Pegs**
- **Plastic sheeting**
- **Buckets and brushes**
- **White crayon**
- **Stirring sticks**
- **Boiling water**
- **Salt**

Feel free to bring any of these materials on the day to use or share if you have them and are able to bring them with you. Much of this will be supplied

Optional:

All materials are available at Spotlight, Lincraft and the super market (SM), Two Dollar Shop.

- **Wool yarn and cotton threads, darning needles, scissors; recycled cotton/woolen fabrics (socks and sleeves), Dacron,:** Spotlight (SL), Lincraft (LC), Two Dollar Shop
- **Recycled cotton, newspaper, palm leaves:** collected from home or second hand shops.
- **Cotton t-shirts:** Spotlight (SL), Lincraft (LC), Two Dollar Shop
- **Strips of coloured card (different colours) newspaper, masking tape, black ink paper.**

The presenter can bring some of these optional items to be shared (i.e. stapler, newspaper, masking tape). Remember, the more fibre materials that are available, the more varied and diverse the day's outcomes will be.
